

IT SCC/GCC Joint Priorities

As discussed with the Government Coordinating Council (GCC)



The industry and government partners in the IT Sector all believe in value of collaboration and partnership. Our collective focus includes activities surrounding risk management, critical infrastructure protection, privacy, and resiliency. All our efforts are conducted with the broader context of the global nature of IT Sector interests and activities in mind.

Common Priority Area A: Risk Management

- Identify, assess, and help facilitate the management of risks to the IT Sector's critical functions, including risks associated with supply chains and dependencies and interdependencies, and facilitate joint understanding between industry and government of those risks.

Common Priority Area B: Cybersecurity Framework

- Better understand the implications of the NIST Cybersecurity Framework for the IT Sector.

Common Priority Area C: Situational Awareness and Information Sharing

- Improve timely, actionable situational awareness for IT Sector partners through defined partnerships and mechanisms such as the IT-ISAC and the NCCIC.

Common Priority Area D: Partnership and Engagement

- Continue to improve the security and resiliency of the IT Sector through collaborative public-private sector partnership, healthy institutions, and innovative risk management and resiliency capabilities.
